

BRATISLAVA'S DOMINANT LANDMARK

The celebratory opening of the new building of the headquarters of the National Bank of Slovakia was held on 23 May 2002 with the presence of the highest state representatives, members of the diplomatic corps, NBS representatives and organisations having been involved in its construction. Other invited guests at the event included distinguished representatives of the banking and financial sector.

The honourable guests were welcomed and a ceremonial speech given by Marián Jusko, the governor of the National Bank of Slovakia. He highlighted the fact that the National Bank of Slovakia built this building along with fulfilling many important and demanding tasks resulting from its position. Through the implementation of its monetary policy it has contributed to stabilisation of domestic macroeconomic development and played no small role in the process of Slovak Republic's gradual integration into international financial and economic structures.

The highly functional and representative premises will enable the more efficient performance of the central bank's functions resulting from the Act on the National Bank of Slovakia.
