


Representatives of the Ministry of Finance SR, Institute of Slovak and World Economy of The Slovak Academy of Sciences and representatives of the National Bank of Slovakia gave their presentation in the congress hall of the central bank's headquarters. The authors presented a broad range of methodological approaches they use in modelling the development of Slovak economy for macroeconomic analysis and prognosis. Besides those institutions giving presentations the seminar was attended by representatives from the academic field, universities and banking institutions operating in Slovakia, who joined in the discussion in evaluating individual papers.

At the same time, the event's organisers informed participants and those reporting on the seminar that the papers presented would be published in an abbreviated form in a supplement to the July issue of the BIATEC banking journal, published by the National Bank of Slovakia.
