#### DECREE

#### of the National Bank of Slovakia

### of 24 June 2008

# laying down the number of decimal places of certain types of securities for the purpose of rounding by redenomination of their nominal value from the Slovak currency to the euro

Pursuant to Article 15, paragraph 9 of the Act No. 659/2007 Coll. on the introduction of the euro currency in the Slovak Republic and on amendments to certain laws, the National Bank of Slovakia, after having consulted the Ministry of Finance of the Slovak Republic, stipulates as follows:

## Article 1

When converting the nominal value of equity securities,<sup>1</sup>) except fund shares, from the Slovak currency to the euro, the number of decimal places in rounding the nominal value of one security shall be not more than six and, if rounded down, not less than two.

### Article 2

When converting the nominal value of debt securities<sup>1</sup>) from the Slovak currency to the euro, the number of decimal places in rounding the nominal value of one security shall be two.

## Article 3

This Decree shall enter into force on 8 July 2008.
