

Note: The standardised credit-to-GDP gap and the benchmark buffer rate based on this indicator are not at present meaningful for the setting of the countercyclical capital buffer (CCyB) rate owing to the shortness of the time series. Hence the Bank is not taking them into account when setting the CCyB rate.
